Good afternoon Wade!

Here are our questions for clarification for the RFP:

- What is the definition of primary care provider (PCP)? Would a Nurse Practitioner qualify?
- Can the PCP be virtual with access during hours of operation? Or must they actually be physically present?
- Can this service be open to the community outside of those already identified (students, staff, OEBB co-dependents)?
- If our model included after hours operations (e.g. 4-8pm) to support sporting/academic events/community immediate care needs, would that be accepted?
- Could you provide us with total square footage?

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Response:

1. Yes, a nurse practitioner would meet PCP expectations.
2. Our intent was that the PCP be present. However, a proposer can propose an alternative delivery model like the one you explain, as detailed in section 3 on page 9 of the RFP.
3. The intent is for this to be limited to the client based as spelled out in Section II.
4. As detailed on item #3(Page 6) and noted in appendix A, suggested hours of operation would fall under "normal working hours," consistent with ~8:30am-4:30pm operational hours. Although small adjustments may be considered (e.g. 7:30am), 4-8pm does not fall under the building's "normal operational hours" and would not be acceptable.
5. Total square footage ~750sqft
