

# **Dutch Bros. Coffee Hermiston supports Kennison project**

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Dutch Bros. Coffee Hermiston, as part of its corporate Buck-4-Kids event, raised \$959.00 for the Kennison Field Renovation Project.

For every drink sold on Friday, December 7, 2012, Dutch Bros. donated \$1.00 to the project, meaning 959 drinks were sold in one day. Marc Lee, Dutch Bros. Coffee Hermiston franchisee, shared that the same event in another eastern Oregon community raised about \$550.00.
