

Kennison Field Fundraising Committee announces first diamond level sponsor

The grant, to be paid over a five-year timeframe, assists in filling the \$700,000 gap in funding, between available resources and facility needs, for the estimated \$4 million project. The KFFC has now raised 52 percent of the necessary funding.
